Uniform is an essential part of our school's identity. It reinforces our values as a community, fosters a sense of belonging, and prepares pupils for the professional expectations they will encounter in the future.

Please note the following reminders regarding uniform requirements:

- **Hoodies, leggings, and jogging bottoms/tracksuits** are not acceptable school uniform.
- **Shorts** are permitted all year but must be **tailored**.
- **Skirts** should be worn at an appropriate length.
- **Footwear** must be **all black** with no visible markings.

If you are unsure whether a particular item of clothing meets the uniform policy, we encourage you to contact the school before purchasing.
